

## Supplemental Licensing Terms and Conditions for Sponsored Articles Published in Blood

American Society of Hematology (“ASH”) has, through certain arrangements with Wellcome Trust, agreed to post final articles sponsored by Wellcome Trust (hereafter referred to as “Articles”) in *Blood, Journal of the American Society of Hematology*, used to generate the definitive published journal article to PubMed Central (“PMC”) or PMC UK (“PMC UK”) mirror sites for non-commercial purposes.

Articles posted to PMC are protected by copyright and are posted to PMC by permission of ASH. At the time of deposit, posted Articles include all changes made during peer review, copyediting and publishing. PMC and PMC mirror site host organizations are responsible for all links within the document and for incorporating any publisher-supplied amendments or retractions issued subsequently. Articles will be available for free to non-subscribers on ASH’s publishing platforms, including *Blood Online*.

PMC or PMCUK mirror site users (“Users”) may access, download, copy, display and redistribute articles, text and data mine content and re-use or adapt content in articles for noncommercial purposes only, subject to the following conditions:

- The authors' moral right to the integrity of their work is not compromised.
- Where content in the Article is identified as belonging to a third party (i.e., party other than ASH or the author(s) of the Article), it is the obligation of the User to ensure that any use thereof complies with the copyright policies of the third party.
- If Article content is copied, downloaded, displayed or redistributed, a link to the appropriate bibliographic citation (authors, journal, article title, volume, issue, page numbers, Digital Object Identifier (DOI) and a link to the definitive published version on *Blood Online*) should be provided. Copyright notices and disclaimers must not be deleted.
- If Article content is re-used, adapted or translated, a link to the appropriate bibliographic citation (authors, journal, article title, volume, issue, page numbers, DOI) and a link to the definitive published version on *Blood Online* must be provided. Copyright notices and disclaimers must not be deleted. The following statement must be prominently displayed on the User’s work: “This is an unofficial adaptation or translation of an article that appeared in *Blood, Journal of the American Society of Hematology*. The American Society of Hematology has not endorsed the content of this adaptation or translation, or the context of its use.”

Use of Articles for commercial purposes is prohibited. Commercial purposes include but are not limited to:

- Copying or downloading of Articles, or linking to such postings, for further redistribution, sale or licensing, for a fee;
- Copying, downloading or posting by a site or service that incorporates advertising with such content;
- Inclusion or incorporation of Article content in other works or services (other than normal quotations and “fair use” with an appropriate citation) that is then available for sale or licensing, for a fee.
- Use of Articles or Article content (other than normal quotations and “fair use” with appropriate citation) by for-profit organizations for promotional purposes, whether for a fee or otherwise.
- Re-published verbatim in part or in whole, either in print or online, other than normal quotations and “fair use” with an appropriate citation where such use is for the purposes of monetary reward by means of sale, resale, license, loan, transfer or other form of commercial exploitation.
- Translating Articles and posting, redistributing, selling or licensing these translations, for a fee.
